PAINTING A FIELD NUMBER USING A STENCIL & AIRLESS STRIPER

EZ-FOLD



ALUMINUM



In this example we are using a Dura number stencil.

Dura and Ez-Fold: Lighter and easier to move with one person.

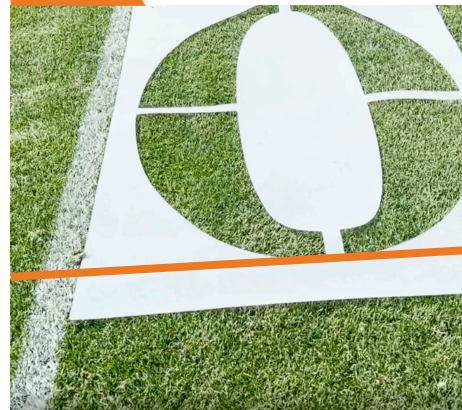
Aluminum stencil: More durable and easier to clean. Requires two people to move.

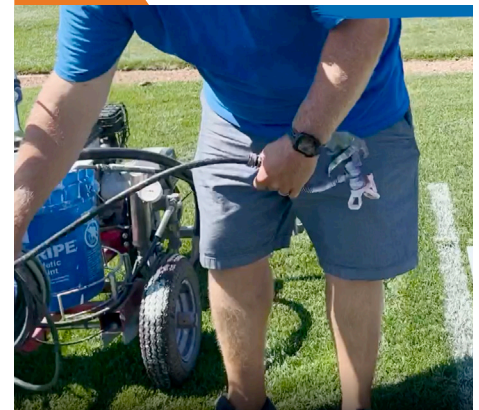
Check league number distance from field line and sideline line.

2



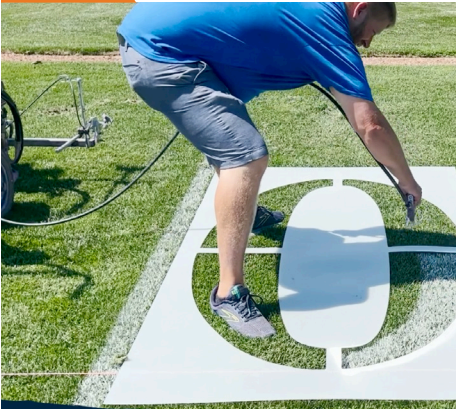
Move stencil to ensure bottom or top of number is straight with string line.

3



Remove paint gun so you can freely move around stencil and paint.

4



With a Dura stencil, step into the numbers to avoid movement of stencil.

5



Remove stencil when done filling it in. Best practice recommends removing with someone at the top and bottom to avoid dripping paint.

6



Go back and fill the gaps and you are done!
